ICARE Training Center Awards Contract for Airbus A320 Std2.1 CEO/NEO Level D Full Flight Simulator to AMST

Morlaix/Nieuw-Vennep, November 2022 – ICARE Training Center, based in Morlaix, France awarded a contract for an AIRFOX FFS device to AMST. The signing ceremony took place at EATS 2022 on 8 November 2022. Under the contract, AMST will deliver an AIRFOX Level D Full Flight Simulator for the Airbus A320 Std2.1 CEO/NEO for type rating and recurrent training.
